## NOTIFICATION TO THE PARTIES

No. 2016/018 Geneva, 15 March 2016

**CONCERNING:** 

Implementation of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13)
(Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species)

## Recommendations of the Standing Committee

- 1. In the context of the Review of Significant Trade in specimens of Appendix-II species, the Standing Committee regularly recommends trade suspensions for countries that it has determined to have failed to implement Article IV of the Convention. The Secretariat last published the list of countries and species affected by these recommendations with Notification to the Parties No. 2015/063 of 26 November 2015.
- 2. At its 66th meeting (SC66, Geneva, January 2016), the Standing Committee reviewed its recommendations to suspend trade covered by Article IV of the Convention that had been in place for more than two years. The Committee decided that its recommendations to Parties to suspend trade in Falco cherrug from Bahrain, Phelsuma comorensis and P. v-nigra from Comoros, Huso huso from Kazakhstan and the Russian Federation, several species in the genera Calumma, Furcifer and Phelsuma from Madagascar, and Balearica regulorum from Rwanda could be withdrawn.
- 3. At SC66, the Standing Committee, having been informed that recommendations made by the Animals Committee in accordance with paragraph n) or o) of Resolution Conf. 12.8 (Rev. CoP13) had not been complied with, also recommended that all Parties suspend trade covered by Article IV of the Convention for specimens of: Chamaeleo gracilis and C. senegalensis from Benin and Ghana; Kinixys homeana from Benin; Trioceros quardricornis from Cameroon; Psittacus erithacus from the Central African Republic; Plerogyra simplex and P. sinuosa from Fiji; Hippocampus algiricus from Guinea and Senegal; Macaca fascicularis, Ptyas mucosus and Python reticulatus from the Lao People's Democratic Republic; Tridacna derasa, T. crocea, T. gigas, T. maxima and T. squamosa from the Solomon Islands; and Kinyongia fischeri and K. tavetana from the United Republic of Tanzania. These recommended trade suspensions will remain in place until these Parties demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Standing Committee, through the Secretariat, compliance with Article IV, paragraphs 2 (a) and 3 for the species concerned, and provided full information to the Secretariat regarding compliance with the recommendations of the Animals Committee.
- 4. Parties are reminded that the complete list of Parties subject to a recommendation to suspend trade is available on the CITES website under <a href="Documents/Trade suspensions">Documents/Trade suspensions</a>.
- 5. Parties are requested to inform their enforcement and Customs authorities of the availability of the list of trade suspension recommendations on the CITES website in order to avoid the inadvertent acceptance of specimens of species subject to such a recommendation. Parties that require the issuance of import permits for trade in specimens of Appendix-II species are also encouraged to consult the list when processing applications.
- 6. The present Notification replaces Notification to the Parties No. 2015/063 of 26 November 2015.

The Standing Committee recommended to suspend trade in Calumma spp.<sup>3</sup> and Furcifer spp.<sup>3</sup> from Madagascar, with the exception of Calumma amber, C. ambreense, C. andringitraense, C. boettgeri, C. brevicorne, C. capuroni, C. crypticum, C. cucullatum, C. fallax, C. furcifer, C. gallus, C. gastrotaenia, C. glawi, C. globifer, C. guibei, C. guillaumeti, C. hafahafa, C. hilleniusi, C. jejy, C. linota, C. malthe, C. marojezense, C. nasutum, C. oshaughnessyi, C. parsonii, C. peltierorum, C. peyrierasi, C. tarzan, C. tsaratananense, C. tsycome, C. vatosoa, C. vencesi and C. vohibola; and Furcifer angeli, F. antimena, F. balteatus, F. belalandaensis, F. bifidus, F. campani, F. lateralis, F. minor, F. monoceras, F. nicosiai, F. oustaleti, F. pardalis, F. petteri, F. rhinoceratus, F. timoni, F. tuzetae, F. verrucosus and F. willsii.

The Standing Committee recommended to suspend trade in *Phelsuma* spp. from Madagascar, with the exception of *P. abbotti*, *P. antanosy*, *P. barbouri*, *P. berghofi*, *P. cependiana*, *P. dubia*, *P. flavigularis*, *P. grandis*, *P. guttata*, *P. hielscheri*, *P. kely*, *P. klemmeri*, *P. kochi*, *P. laticauda*, *P. lineata*, *P. madagascariensis*, *P. malamakibo*, *P. masohoala*, *P. modesta*, *P. mutabilis*, *P. pronki*, *P. pusilla*, *P. quadriocellata*, *P. roesleri*, *P. seippi*, *P. serraticauda*, and *P. vanheygeni*.
