Withdrawal of a recommendation to suspend trade

- 1. In Notification to the Parties No. 2016/023 of 16 March 2016, the Secretariat informed Parties that, pursuant to Resolution Conf. 11.17 (Rev. CoP16), the Standing Committee had recommended that Parties not authorize trade in specimens of CITES-listed species with the Solomon Islands as it had failed, without having provided adequate justification, to provide annual reports for three consecutive years.
- 2. On 28 March 2016, the Secretariat received from the Solomon Islands its annual reports for the years 2013 and 2014.
- 3. The Secretariat therefore informs Parties that the recommendation to suspend trade in specimens of CITES-listed species with the Solomon Islands is withdrawn with immediate effect.
